Clarification on Information Technology (Reasonable Security Practices and Procedure Personal Data or Information) Rules, 2011 Under Section 43A of the Information Techno PRESS NOTE

The Department of Information Technology had notified Information Technology (Reasonable sec procedures and sensitive personal data or information) Rules, 2011 under section 43A of the Infor Act, 2000 on 11.4.2011 vide notification no. G.S.R. 313(E).

These rules are regarding sensitive personal data or information and are applicable to the body corporate located within India. Any such body corporate providing services relating to collection, storage, dea sensitive personal data or information under contractual obligation with any legal entity located within not subject to the requirement of Rules 5 & 6. Body corporate, providing services to the provider o a contractual obligation directly with them, as the case may be, however, is subject to Rules 5 information, as referred to in these Rules, are those natural persons who provide sensitive personal to a body corporate. It is also clarified that privacy policy, as prescribed in Rule 4, relates to the bo not with respect to any particular obligation under any contract. Further, in Rule 5(1) consent include any mode of electronic communication.


